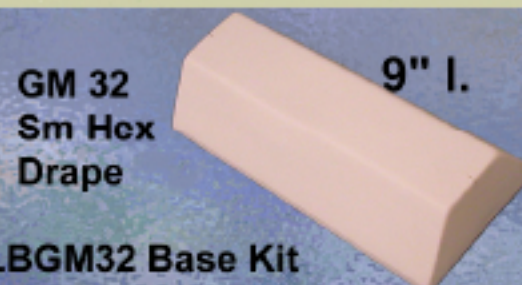

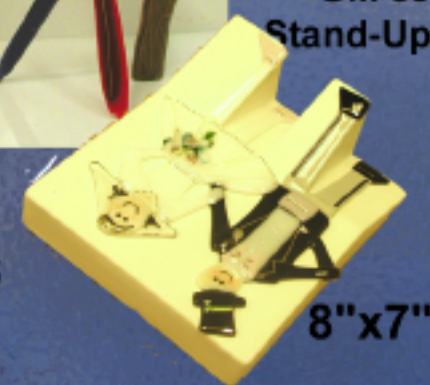

Materials:

Kimble Colors Used:

924 Teal, **908** Tawny Beige, **909** Gentle Flesh, **901** Bone, **944** Barn Red, **925** Medium Blue, **900** White, **905** Rich Brown, **903** Smoke, **902** Black, **901** Bone, **922** Navy, **718** Amber, **764** Antique Media, **918** Forest Green, **913** Blush, **711** Sapphire, **713** Primrose, **714** Teal, **700** White, **761** Perfect Matte Spray, **904** Light Grey, **906** Cocoa Brown, **910** Scarlet Red, **930** Sun Ray, **972** Silver, **971** Gold, **977** Ultra Glitz

Other Miscellaneous Materials:

Hair Spray



Technique:

Basecoat the following areas with the following colors:

- Coat with **924** Teal.
- Fur and beard with **908** Tawny Beige.
- Face with **909** Gentle Flesh.
- Collar and vest with **901** Bone.
- Gloves with **944** Barn Red.
- Sky and water in scene with **925** Medium Blue.
- Lighthouse and Sail with **900** White.
- Rock and boat with **905** Rich Brown.
- Houses with **903** Smoke.
- Roofs with **902** Black.
- Light quilt squares with **901** Bone.
- Dark quilt squares with **922** Navy.

Antique the entire piece with **718** Amber and wipe back using a soft paper towel and **764** Antique Media.

Use a stiff, round, dry brush to drybrush areas. It may be necessary to touch up basecoat after drybrushing. When an area requires highlighting after drybrushing, a small amount of the lighter color should be applied to the end of the previously used dry brush and worked into the brush by using a clean paper towel before lightly applying to the desired highlighted areas.

Drybrush the following areas with the following colors, keeping the previous paragraph in mind:

- Coat with **918** Forest Green. Highlight with 900 White using method detailed previously.
- Fur with 908 Tawny Beige. Highlight with 900 White.
- Beard with 900 White.
- Face with 909 Gentle Flesh. Blush cheeks using same brush loaded with a small amount of **913** Blush.
- Collar, vest, and light quilt squares with 901 Bone. Highlight with 900 White.
- Gloves with 944 Barn Red and highlight with 900 White.
- Dark quilt squares with 922 Navy. Highlight with 900 White.

For the Nautical Scene detail:

- Use a lightly loaded filbert brush. Apply **711** Sapphire to the top of the sky and blend downwards. Apply **713** Primrose to the bottom of the sky and blend upwards. Use a separate, clean brush to blend the two together to create a smooth transition. If desired, create distant clouds using a small drybrush tipped very lightly with **700** White and pounce clouds into the sky.
- Apply **714** Teal to the water and pat back with a clean brush to desired translucency. Use a moistened paper towel to wipe off all color from the lighthouse, boat, houses, moon, and rock. Let dry, and spray with **761** Perfect Matte Spray in a well-ventilated area.

Drybrush the moon with **904** Light Grey and highlight with 900 White. Drybrush the lighthouse and sails with 900 White, and the houses and their roofs with 903 Smoke. Drybrush the rocks and boat with **906** Cocoa Brown. Paint the lighthouse's band and roof with **910** Scarlet Red, and the lit area of the lighthouse with **930** Sun Ray. Paint rays of light coming from the lighthouse with 930 Sun Ray and 900 White. Paint the upper band and rails on top of the lighthouse, as well as the lines on the boat's sail with 902 Black. Apply 900 White to random areas of the scene to serve as snow, and small, short, horizontal lines on the water as light reflections.

Use a small detail brush to define the dark areas of the quilt with 922 Navy and light areas of the quilt with 901 Bone, referring to the picture as needed.

Paint the anchor **972** Silver and the rope and coat buttons **971** Gold. Paint the eyes 900 White, irises 925 Medium Blue, and lashes and lines 902 Black. Paint a line on the bottom of the vest and collar with 922 Navy.

Spray the scene with hair spray and sprinkle with **977** Ultra Glitz while still wet.
