## Ladybug Rattle

## Materials:

- Moist White low-fire clay
- HP07 Oval Hump
- Soft cloth filled with sand and tied off into a bag
- Clay trimming tools (such as fettling knife)
- Small soft sponge
- Paper towels

Step 1: Roll out a $9^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ slab of clay.

Step 2: Drape the slab over HP07 Oval Hump, and pounce clay around the hump with the sandbag.

Step 3: Trim excess clay around the base of the hump, and clean with damp sponge.

Step 4: Allow the clay to get leather hard and then gently lift off the mold.

Step 5: Set the clay on an 8 " $\times 8$ " slab, and trim around the base of the humped clay that will form the ladybug's shell.

Step 6: Roll 4 or 5 pea-sized balls, depending on how "rattley" you want your rattle, wrap them in a paper towel, and put under the shell on top of the 8 " $\times 8$ " slab before replacing the shell. This creates the rattle.

Step 7: Score and attach the shell to the bottom slab with slip.

Step 8: Trim any excess clay around the bottom edge, and clean with a damp sponge.

Step 9: Draw a line on the ladybug's shell to delineate the head and wing sections.

Step 10: Roll small balls and flatten for spots and eyes. Roll a small coil for the lips.

Step II: Roll 6 quarter-sized balls for feet. Score and attach with slip.

Step 12: Allow to dry completely before firing and glazing.
