

<u>Step I</u>: Roll out a 9" x 9" slab of clay.

Step 2: Drape the slab over HP07 Oval Hump, and pounce clay around the hump with the sandbag.

<u>Step 3</u>: Trim excess clay around the base of the hump, and clean with damp sponge.

<u>Step 4</u>: Allow the clay to get leather hard and then gently lift off the mold.

<u>Step 5</u>: Set the clay on an 8" x 8" slab, and trim around the base of the humped clay that will form the ladybug's shell.

<u>Step 6</u>: Roll 4 or 5 pea-sized balls, depending on how "rattley" you want your rattle, wrap them in a paper towel, and put under the shell on top of the 8" x 8" slab before replacing the shell. This creates the rattle.

Ladybug Rattle

Materials:

- Moist White low-fire clay
- HP07 Oval Hump
- Soft cloth filled with sand and tied off into a bag
- Clay trimming tools (such as fettling knife)
- Small soft sponge
- Paper towels

<u>Step 7</u>: Score and attach the shell to the bottom slab with slip.

<u>Step 8</u>: Trim any excess clay around the bottom edge, and clean with a damp sponge.

<u>Step 9</u>: Draw a line on the ladybug's shell to delineate the head and wing sections.

Step 10: Roll small balls and flatten for spots and eyes. Roll a small coil for the lips.

<u>Step II</u>: Roll 6 quarter-sized balls for feet. Score and attach with slip.

<u>Step 12</u>: Allow to dry completely before firing and glazing.

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
